**Title**– In bold letter. Please do not include author name, affiliation or other detail in word file as we follow double blind peer review process but include it in step of submission.

Discussion (Discuss the result with support of recent references)

Conclusion

Keywords: 3-6. It should be in alphabetical order.

## **Introduction**

The introduction should establish the overall tone of the paper by clearly stating the study's purpose, referencing pertinent academic sources, and outlining the suggested course of action. The introduction must to be sufficiently all-encompassing to catch the interest of readers from a variety of scholarly fields.

## **Methods**

Present the research design, research type, research duration, inclusion/exclusion criteria, choice of subjects, etc. Describe the methodology completely, including sample collection, processing, lab analysis, statistical tests used for data analysis etc. Use section headings/subheadings in a logical order to entitle each category or method. (e.g. 1, 2; 1.1, 2.1; 1.1.1, 2.1.1...etc)

## **Results**

The results section should provide all of the information about the experiment needed to support the study's conclusion. When summarizing the outcomes of the authors' experiments, the results should be written in the past tense. Findings that have already been published should be expressed in the present tense. Results and comments can be included in one part or two. Speculation and in-depth analyses of the data ought to be provided in the discussion section rather than the results.

## **Discussion**

Provide an interpretation of your results. The significance of findings should be clearly described. If your results differ from your expectations, explain why that may have happened. If your results agree, then describe the theory that the evidence supported.

## **Conclusion**

The main conclusions of the experimental work should be presented. The contribution of the work to the scientific research and its economic implications should be emphasized. This section included briefly detailed conclusive parameters of the whole study.

## **Recommendations if any:**

Authors' contributions: It should be included in revised manuscript.

Acknowledgements: Source of fund for the study must be mentioned along with other helps and facilities. Help from any person should be acknowledged here.

Competing interests:

References: References must be as per Pubmed style. All journal abbreviation must be as per standard journal abbreviation. Full name or non-standardised journal name should not be allowed. Tables: Include it at the last of manuscript. Please do not include between the text.

Figures/graphs etc.: Please do not include figures in Word file but upload the PNG/JPG file of each figure in submission site step. However, include figure caption in word file. Figure should be of more than 300 dpi.
